Notes from Fr. Keith for 1/25/2009

As you may have seen in the Catholic Missourian, next Sunday we will be asking you to fill out cards to send to our Senators and Congressman Skelton to oppose the Freedom of Choice Act. This bill has been introduced in Congress twice in the past five years: it never made it out of the Judiciary Committee, however then Senator Obama was a co-sponsor in 2007 and said he would sign it as President. The Freedom of Choice Act will essentially make Row vs. Wade permanent (more information is available on the Internet and the Catholic Missourian, and will be available in the bulletin and the entryway next week).

This is a bad piece of legislation in several ways: it is immoral in making abortion an inalienable right, and it will set a bad precedent in the arbitrary Federal abolition of Local and State laws and regulations. It is fortunate we have time to act, since this bill has not yet been introduced into this Congress (as of Wednesday afternoon when I write this), and we have time to make our voices to our representatives heard. The President cannot sign a bill that does not reach his desk. Please join me next week in letting Senators Bond and McCaskill and Congressman Skelton know our opposition to this bill, and urging them to do everything in their power to see that it does not pass.
