What do you do when you know everything? Other than bothering people like me who really do

...

All right, just kidding. Many of you probably took the quiz in the Catholic Missourian, and perhaps you did very well, maybe you even scored 100%. So you may be wondering: "Why sign up for Why Catholic? I know everything I need to know."

It's not about knowledge of the facts, it's about knowledge of the heart. The first session focuses on the Scripture: "For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also". We can all agree this is true, I think. So do you treasure your Faith above everything else in your life? Is this what you spend most of your time with? Is this something you would like to see grow? Unlike other investments, it doesn't grow unless you work on it, it starts to die.
