A Letter From Bishop Gaydos

October 4, 2009

My Dearly Beloved People of the Diocese of Jefferson City,

Today on October 4th, Respect Life Sunday, we join with Catholics throughout the United States in celebrating God's gift of human life. This year the theme is "Every Child Brings Us God's Smile," words of Pope Benedict XVI. These words are both simple and deep, inviting our pause, reflection, and prayer.

As people of faith, these words inspire many things we do day in and day out, sometimes without thinking. But, I invite you to consider them. I am so very grateful for your dedication, love, and respect for God's gift of human life.

Sometimes, it is not easy and maybe we do not notice God's smile. Indeed, God's gift of human life is being attacked from many angles: abortion, embryonic stem cell research, legalized suicide, attitudes that some lives are not worth living, and some lives are not worth protecting.
