A New Year has begun, and it's time to start thinking a little different to accommodate. You know what I mean.

We are close to another session of Why Catholic? during Lent 2010. There will be another exciting 3 sessions to help us explore our faith. The topics for this Lent are: The Public Life of Jesus/The Paschal Mystery/The Holy Spirit and the Church/One Church with Diverse Roles/Mary, the Mother of the Church/We Believe in Life Everlasting.
