## Notes from Fr. Keith, 02/28/2010

Next week our Bishops are asking us to send postcards to our Congressmen and Senators to support Immigration reform. The Church teaches that work is a basic human right that has dignity, and people have the right to migrate to find work. Our Bishops do not condone breaking laws, but recognizes our system allows large scale abuse of people legitimately seeking work, which is unjust, and is desperately in need of change so justice can be done for all. This is a Pro-Life issue.

There is a lot of misleading information about undocumented workers out there, and hostile attitudes that result from this misinformation. We must remember that our ancestors were immigrants who came here to find work; they kept their traditions, customs and language as best they could while making their lives here, and laid their lives down for this country both in their labor and their defense of our country. There is not enough space here to rebut all the misinformation about Immigration issues: please listen to everything the Church has to say on this issue and respond to our drive next Sunday.
