## Notes from Fr. Keith, 3/21/2010

What do we get out of prayer? After all, a dogma of this culture is if you aren't getting anything out of what you're doing, you should give it up. I've talked a lot about prayer this year, and at the end, the question of 'why pray?' comes up.

The wrong answer seems to be: "How can I get God to do what I want?" Do we know better how the world should be run than God does? Is there something God doesn't know we need to remind Him to do? Is God the Cosmic Butler who makes life easy for us, and we need to get our orders in?

The right answer seems to be: "How can I do what God wants?" Remember the phrase from the Lord's Prayer: "Thy Kingdom Come". Prayer is the beginning of how we offer ourselves to God, which leads to how we live our lives. Prayer is the first step in our response to Christ's love for us, poured out on the Cross in His Blood.

We pray because we need to; we pray because it's good for us. Prayer is its own reward.
