Notes from Fr. Keith, 3/28/2010

Every year we have a Parish Mission. It's a profound experience that gets to the roots of our Christian faith: the origins of the Eucharist, the nature of the priesthood, the unselfishness of Christ, the dark night of the soul, the nature of betrayal, the confrontation of pure evil, the emptiness of abandonment, and the nature of hope beyond despair. It's called the Triduum (Latin for 3 days); it begins in the evening of Holy Thursday and ends Easter Sunday.

Sure, it seems like a long journey, however it's a journey that will change how you see Easter morning. We want to get to Resurrection, perhaps we want to get there too quickly, but that celebration will be a deeper experience if you walk the journey of the Triduum first. Make some time this week and spend it on this Parish Mission with Christ, who gave everything for us. The journey may take us a few extra miles, but no farther than our Savior has gone for us, and your patience will be rewarded.
