Notes from Fr. Keith, 5/2/2010

This week on Tuesday night, 6 young people of St. Ann Parish receive the Sacrament of the Confirmation at St. Patrick's in Sedalia. This sacrament represents an end and a beginning.

Confirmation is the end of the Initiation process that began at Baptism. It's something they have been preparing for directly for the past year, and in some ways, their entire lives.

The Outpouring of the Spirit through the Sacrament of Confirmation is also a beginning. Now these young people are full members of the Church, and their challenge is to proclaim the Faith and build up the Body of Christ just as the Apostles were as they received the outpouring of the Spirit at Pentecost. As they return from their journey to Bishop Gaydos to receive the Sacrament, let us not only include them in our prayers as they enter this new part of their Faith journey, but also invite them to take their place at our sides as together we proclaim the Risen Christ to the world.
