Notes from Fr. Keith 5/30/2010

When I was in college, I played the viola in the orchestra for three years. Our orchestra had excellent wind and percussion sections, since the band program was strong, but most of us in the string sections had been on our third or fourth instruments a couple of years, so we had a great challenge to overcome. Our director encouraged us to keep working and asked us to practice more in this way: "I don't want your study time, I don't want your sleep time, I don't want time you have to spend doing the necessary things in life. I want your goof off time." And we did, and we got somewhat better even though we weren't ready for Carnegie Hall.

These days, I think our goof off time gets too high a priority, and I realize that's borderline heresy here in vacation county. Rest and recreation are necessary, but just as we have to keep up with our basic needs during the summer like eating, sleeping, family time and personal care, we have to keep working on our faith needs whether we're on vacation or not. God is the giver of all time, and we sometimes forget that. God does not take time away from us.
