**Notes from Fr. Keith 6/20/10**

*Pope Benedict XVI proclaimed this past year, which officially ended Saturday June 19, 2010 to be a holy Year of the Priest. This date was chosen because it is the anniversary of the death of St. John Vianney (the Curé of Ars), the patron saint of parish priests.*

It is difficult for me to speak about priesthood, because it hits so close to who I am. Pope Benedict's letter for this year speaks about the priesthood being first a gift and then an office, and he's right about that. He also speaks of ". . .(an) aspiration to moral perfection that must dwell in every authentically priestly heart" and this is also a powerful part of my journey. Despite the skepticism about some aspects of the lives of Priests, I feel it is a healthy, complete, wholesome and authentic way of being. True, there are challenges and failures: at my ordination mass, the Bishop told me: "You will fail as Peter failed." However, we all have challenges and failures and since we're all human there is no getting away from that.

The phrase that struck me most from the Pope's letter was: ". . .the mission is "ecclesial" because no one proclaims himself in the first person, but within and through his own humanity every priest must be well aware that he is bringing to the world Another, God himself. God is the only treasure which ultimately people desire to find in a priest." Living out this challenge is the greatest challenge, the greatest privilege, and the greatest blessing. It is the most fantastic way of living I could have ever imagined.
