Notes from Fr. Keith 8/01/10

“Why Catholic?” is returning. This Fall we will begin another journey of Faith, this year we will traverse the power of the Sacraments we celebrate. Sacraments are about the Real Presence of Christ in our lives that we experience not only every week, but also at important points of our lives, such as Baptism, Confirmation, Marriage, Death. To be Catholic is to be a Sacramental person.

The format will be the same as we used last spring: we will schedule 3 nights over 3 weeks on the same night of the week, we will celebrate the Eucharist, share a meal, and break open our Faith as we reflect and share faith on how we celebrate Christ in our lives.

Even if you did not take part in “Why Catholic?” last year, you are welcome to be part of it this year. You will not have to start behind everyone; we begin the journey through the Sacraments afresh. If you can't make it all 3 nights, you are welcome to come as you can. What I think is important in the new emphasis on Evangelization Pope Benedict XVI has announced, is that we must understand and own our faith as best we can in order to reach out to others to help them discover their faith.
