Suicide is the 3rd ranking cause of death in youth ages 10-24. It is the 11th cause of death in Missouri. The suicide rate in Benton County has soared in recent months. Suicide is preventable and Pathways Behavioral Community Healthcare, Inc is offering a best practice training. Cindy Gunter, Pathways Suicide Prevention Coordinator will present the 45-60 minute training that will equip youth and adults to recognize the warning signs and to intervene in such a way as to save a life. Notes from Fr. Keith 8/15/10

It's been said you can be a good person without going to Church or practicing your Faith very much. It's true, but what usually bothers me is the conversation usually ends there. Atheists go on to say that since you can be a good person without Faith, why bother with it because it's more trouble than it's worth. However, we shouldn't let the conversation stop there. The purpose of Faith isn't only about being a good person; in some ways, being a good person is a result of practicing Faith well.
