Notes from Fr. Keith, 12/5/2010

This is a season for generosity, and to be mindful of those in need. Our parishes have done a lot in the past year to reach out to the poor through local charities, but a lot of that outreach has come through a local charity you may not be aware of.

It's the St. Joseph's Table: a fund supported by both St. Ann and Sts. Peter and Paul parishes, expressly for helping those who come by the office. We help people with utilities, rent and prescriptions out of this fund, and this is above and beyond what other local charities such as Warm House provide. It receives funds from the Altar Society's St. Joseph's Table which is held every March, contributions from Sts. Peter and Paul's Parish Council, a grant from Orschlen's, and individual contributions.
