Another New Year has begun. It seems like just when we get used to the old one, the new one is upon us. Part of life, I guess.

As usual, I'm not really sure what the new year will bring: I don't know about you, but every time I've planned ahead more than a short time, God has laughed at me and sent me a different direction. There are long term goals we need to make to keep us moving forward, but it's not a good idea to get *too* invested in them.

The key thing about the New Year, as with every New Year, is living the Gospel and being people of the Eucharist. It's about remembering our universal connections through the Blood of Christ, and how our Blood relationships call us to follow Christ.
