Notes from Fr. Keith, 1/9/2011

This week is Vocation Awareness Week. Discerning a Vocation is a time to look inward, because it's something that emerges from who we are, as well as looking outward, seeing the call through the needs of others. For me, the journey of Vocation is a journey of self-discovery: our Vocation comes from the best we can be for ourselves and the best we can be for others. It's about seeing the Truth all around us, seeing the blessings and challenges of living the Faith, seeing our strengths and weaknesses honestly and embracing the Mission of Christ. It's about making choices that are both easy and hard at the same time, and trying to trust completely in Christ as the source of all our strength. It's about seeing the hunger for the Word and the need for the healing power of the Blood of Christ all around us and responding as Isaiah did: "Here I am, Lord. Send me."
