Notes from Fr. Keith 2/27/2011

Liturgy is the Public Work of the Church. It has two pillars: the Eucharist (Mass) and the Divine Office. The Eucharist is celebrated somewhere in the world almost every day of the year, the Divine Office is the Liturgy of the Hours prayed by Religious and lay people around the clock. Both these kinds of prayer are bound to the rhythm of the seasons, traveling the Life of Christ in as completely as possible through the course of the year.. Liturgical Prayer is about the Sanctification of Time, among other things it is about making all Time God's Time.

Our approach to Liturgical Prayer isn't about self-expression, it's about expressing Christ. We are called to pour ourselves into this prayer and by formed by it into the Image of Christ. Particularly in the Eucharist, we are part of Christ's prayer to the Father (John 17), offered by Christ to Him and consecrated to the Truth. Also in the Eucharist, Christ comes to us through two altars: the Altar of the Word, and the Altar of His Body and Blood.

Liturgical Prayer isn't about entertainment, good feelings, or doing what we want. It is about the presence of Christ active in the world today. It's also at the core of who we are and what we believe, it is the primary laboratory where we put what we believe into practice.
