Notes from Fr. Keith for 5/8/2011

Isaiah 66: 12-13 says: “For thus says the LORD: Lo, I will spread prosperity over her like a river, and the wealth of the nations like an overflowing torrent. As nurslings, you shall be carried in her arms, and fondled in her lap; As a mother comforts her son, so will I comfort you; in Jerusalem you shall find your comfort.” We don't often associate mother love with God's love, but there's several times this metaphor is used in the Scripture. A famous quote from the New Testament is Matthew 23:37: “Jerusalem, Jerusalem, you who kill the prophets and stone those sent to you, how many times I yearned to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her young under her wings. . .”

We celebrate Mother's Day this weekend; let us remember that Mother Love is another form of God's Love.
