Notes from Fr. Keith, 6/19/2011

Father's Day. The name "Father" means different things to different people, depending on how their father's were. There's something to be said about the difference between a "Father" and a "Dad.": a sign of intimacy that goes beyond the biological. For me, I go back to an important time in any man's life: the time his father first recognizes him as an adult. That's an important empowerment, it was in my life, and unfortunately everyone doesn't get such a moment.

We call God our Father, and on reflection both of these ideas are working as we see God as our ideal Father. Jesus called God "Abba", the Aramaic equivalent to "Daddy", a label that scandalized many. God our Father does always treat us as adults, whether we deserve it or not. He always give us Free Choice, and he respects that Free Choice absolutely. It's not like He's at a distance: He's there when we need Him and call on Him. He does give us the strength to grow and learn on our own, and in that empowerment, makes it possible for us to return to Him on a different level we began before: as mature believers who have found Him on our own.
