Notes from Fr. Keith 9/18/2011

Next month, we'll be conducting our educational sessions to prepare for implementation of the new translation of the Roman Missal on November 26. Our main guide will be Fr. Paul Turner's Understanding the Revised Mass Texts, Second Edition. In Warsaw, these sessions will be Thursday nights, October 6, 13, and 20 from 6:30-7:30PM; in Cole Camp, they will take place after Mass on October 9, 16, 23. If you don't have one of the pamphlets already, we will be receiving a new supply in the very near future. These sessions will cover both the changes and the new music we will be using in the new translation.

As we prepare for the new translation, we will also be exploring the nature of the Mass, how it developed, and our expectations of the Eucharist. It will be a unique opportunity to grow in our understanding of the central act of our Faith.
