Notes from Fr. Keith 9/25/2011

What does vocation mean? Is it a career choice we make, a job we take on? No, vocation is more than any other career or occupation: it is part of our very souls, it is who God made us to be. Vocation is finding the purpose of why God put us here, and how we are best to serve Him. As we seek our vocation, we explore the inner landscape of our souls and how that landscape fits the needs of others like a jigsaw puzzle. This journey is a holy pilgrimage that reveals how God wants us in particular, to move in this world and serve Him best.
