Notes from Fr. Keith, 2/05/2012

It's been a little over two months since we implemented the New Translation of the Mass, and you may be wondering how we're doing. I know that the new texts make me study them ahead of Mass so I can say them and make sense.

There are still times I get a little confused and forget where I am in the book, and at times I get words turned around. I think as parishes we're doing all right so far: there are times we lapse back into the old responses, but that's to be expected. My music career taught me that having to unlearn old habits and relearn new ones is the most difficult learning we do, and in music I would work on that retraining for hours daily, which is far less time than we've been able to spend on the task. Anxiety will not bend the learning curve a more favorable direction any quicker.

I'd say we're around 75-80% converted so far, and improving. The stories I hear from other parishes indicate they're having adjustment issues as well, so I don't think we're lagging behind (as if this were a contest). It will take a lot more time until we're very secure and almost perfect with the new responses, maybe as long as Easter or beyond, and even longer until we're comfortable with them. That's to be expected, and I'm not bothered. We will be using these words for decades, and in around 20 years, we'll have forgotten how often we needed 2 tries to get together on "And with your Spirit."

It's the honest effort to get things right that matters, and will see us through this time of transition in a Charitable Spirit. We're doing all right.
