Notes from Fr. Keith, 2/19/2012

This week we begin another Lenten journey. Our approach to Lent is all important: Lent is doing with our lives the same kind of thing we've been doing with the text of the Mass the past few months. Lent is supposed to retrain us and perfect ourselves.

The main techniques of Lent are Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving. These three work together and shouldn't be separated. Focus too much on one and our Spring Training isn't as effective as it could be, we lose perspective and either fail to see ourselves as we should or we fail to see ourselves as part of the bigger picture.. Lent is where we strive to improve ourselves to be better imitators of Christ. We're already working on that; Lent is where we work harder. The better we can imitate Christ, take on the attitude and compassion of Christ, the better we become the best people we can be, we become more of what God wants us to be.

But Lent isn't just about making ourselves better Christians and better people individually: it's about becoming a better community in Christ as a parish and as a larger Church. Jesus didn't call us to be Lone Rangers for Him, He calls us all to be part of his mystical Body and grow in greater Unity with one another. Lent is where we should grow closer in our common commitment to Christ. Lent is where we learn to imitate Christ's offering Himself for the sake of the world.
