Notes from Fr. Keith for 3/25/2012

Lent is a time when we've been making room for God, I hope. We give up things we like, we give up behaviors that are bad for us, so make space for Christ to fill. It's not easy, but it's the objective if we're doing this right.

One thing Jesus never said in Scripture is: "Make sure you have things the way you want them." I've run into people who seem to think this is in the Bible, but there's nothing like it in there. "Don't settle for less than what you want," isn't there either, or "your wants are just as important as your needs."

One problem with selfishness is it eats up space Christ should have. When we put ourselves first with no regard to the consequences, how it affects us, or how it affects others, we deny the Great Commandment: "Love one another as I have loved you." This doesn't mean we should ignore our legitimate needs or put ourselves down, but we should be real with ourselves and let the Spirit guide us with Divine Wisdom to know the difference between what we need and what we want.

Christ emptied Himself for us. We are called to empty ourselves if we are to imitate Him.
