## **Notes from Fr. Keith for 4/01/2012**

If we're health conscious, we sample when we go to a buffet. A little of this and a little of that, not too much of anything if we're going to control our weight. Try it and see if you like it, and at a later time you can go back for more, but not too much. Letting go and eating too much is very tempting (a temptation I've given into far too often), but is bad for us in many, many ways.

Holy Week is a feast, not a buffet. We aren't asked to sample this and that, we're called to sit down and have everything. This is not a time to pick and sample at our spiritual life, this is a time to dive in and savor the feast. This is a time to be stuffed with Grace, a time to be inebriated with the Spirit of Christ. Make your life revolve around the Church this week, go to as much of the Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday) you can. Take part in everything, full throttle. Easter Sunday will be much more powerful if you've walked the entire journey with Christ. Jesus isn't something we do in moderation, and new life in Christ is something impossible to overdo.
