## Notes for 4/15/2012 from Fr. Keith

When Jesus returned from the dead, could He have stayed longer? Did it have to be just 40 days? He could still be here now in the flesh, still able to walk and talk with us. It would have limited him greatly, He wouldn't have had the access to as many of us as He has now, and not many of us would have been able to see Him. When He was here after His Resurrection, I'm sure He and his disciples made the most out of every moment they had, knowing it was limited.

Our time together is limited. That's the course of all things: none of us are here forever, of course, and sooner or later people move on, one way or the other. We wish we could spend more time with people we care about, and that becomes more real when we know that time is coming to an end. But no matter where we are or who we're with, the moment that matters is Now: we live in Today and what we do with it makes all the difference in the world. We can't change the past, and the future's not here yet. Making plans is always a guess, because they can change any moment. As Christians, it's said we live for Tomorrow, but I think that the assurance of Tomorrow with Christ means we can focus on Today. Christ is alive and with us now: Today has to be what we live for, Today is when we have to be present to each other, because all things change sooner or later.
