Notes for 5/6/2012

On Thursday, May 10, from 1:00-4:00 PM, St. Ann will be hosting the Senior Resource Panel, an event sponsored by the Benton County Health Department. It will be a one stop place to find out a great deal of information on programs and strategies for people approaching care decisions for themselves and those they love as they reach the time when some kind of ongoing assistance is needed. In addition to the Health Department, there will be representatives from Care Connection, Home Health, a local Nursing home, Hospice, the Department of Family Services, and a local investment counselor. There will be expertise on a great number of Government programs, Veterans Administration offerings, legal issues, trusts availabilities and other related subjects. Each presenter will speak for 15-20 minutes and will be able to take questions from the floor; there will be many handouts available as well.

This panel came from a conversation I had with Debbie Joy last November, and I'm very glad these people have decided to come together to provide this unique chance for everyone to learn about what's available. Usually, decisions on someone needing care are made at the last minute under pressure and the information is difficult to access. This is not just for Senior Citizens, it's for everyone, whether you are thinking ahead to your own care plans or are setting up something for someone you love.
