Bishop's Letter Regarding the Pentecost Sunday Combined Collection for the Catholic Communication Campaign and The Catholic University of America

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On the weekend of Pentecost, May 26-27, the parishes of our Diocese will participate in a combined collection for the **Catholic Communication Campaign (CCC)** and **The Catholic University of America** in Washington, D.C. The Collection for the CCC provides grants to spread the Good News through Internet podcasts, television, radio, print media and Catholic social media networks. The Catholic University of America is unique as the national university of the Catholic Church and the only higher education institution founded by the U.S. bishops and chartered by the Vatican.

Through the Catholic Communication Campaign, the words of the Holy Father in his 2011 World Communications Day Message are brought to life. He encouraged young people to "make good use of their presence in the digital world." The CCC Collection supported this goal by funding a Virtual Pilgrimage to World Youth Day last year. The Virtual Pilgrimage, which was available on Facebook, allowed participants to create a virtual faith community through animated

representations of themselves, or avatars. Online participants were able to exchange videos, blog and postings.

CUA, as the national Catholic university, has a special responsibility to educate future leaders for our Church and our Nation. So, in a way, The Catholic University of America belongs to all of us in the Church, regardless of where we live. Students at Catholic University receive personalized attention in a wide range of programs and are grounded in the philosophy of the Catholic intellectual tradition. As a result, these students are well prepared for success in life and ready to make a difference in today's world.

Our Diocese retains some of the proceeds from the CCC collection to support our local communication efforts, such as the **radio Mass** from St. Francis Xavier in Taos, the **Table Talk** program and the **Mustard Seed** radio programs in California and Moberly. This year it will help with the redesign of our diocesan Website, www.diojeffcity.org. Funds provided through the CUA collection will help underwrite the financial aid program at the university, directly benefitting students from all over the United States, including some from our diocese.

I appeal to you today to give generously to the joint collection for the Catholic Communication Campaign and The Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C. Please join in the important work of bearing Christ's witness in the world by your support of Catholic communications and the CUA's mission to educate the next generation of Catholic leaders.
