## Notes from Fr. Keith for 6/03/2012

Taking leave is a bittersweet time. It's a time to cherish memories, to celebrate past accomplishments, to reflect on the meaning others have had in our lives. It's also a time of mourning: a sadness that things can't stay the same indefinitely, a loss of habits of living and affection we'd rather not let go of. In the daily readings recently, we read Paul's farewell speech to the elders of Ephesus, a speech where he sums up the time he's spent with them and where the Spirit is leading him to (Acts 20:13-38). Parting is something we never want to do, but something we have to do from time to time, especially at this time of the year

Taking leave is a sacred time. Next week, the Missionaries of the Precious Blood (myself included) will take some sacred time here on Sunday evening to reflect on our journey here with you, and prayerfully take our leave (although it's not my last weekend here). I hope you can come be part of this time with us; several other members of the community will be here including our Provincial, Fr. Joe Nassal. As we contemplate our parting, it's good to remember that we will always have our present sharing now in the Body and Blood of Christ with the Universal Church, and we have a glorious future together to come in the fullness of the Kingdom of Heaven.
