Notes from Fr. Keith, 6/17/2012

Hearing Fr. Joe Nassal's homily last weekend, I got a new insight on the nature of the Eucharist. Sharing at the Table is a profound connection that goes farther than I contemplated before. In the Eucharist, we are all connected with Christ, we are connected with the Saints and faithful who have lived through the ages, and we are connected with Pope Benedict, Bishop Gaydos, and Catholic Christians around the world. We may approach the Table at different times of day in different places, but the connection we share is timeless. As one world, we come together in Christ.

Next week, we'll be around the Table together one more time here in Benton County. It's a bit sad, and I feel sad contemplating it, to be sure. But every time I preside at Mass in the future, no matter where I will be, you will all be there with me, and every time you celebrate Mass here with Fr. Mike or any of his successors through the years, I and the other Missionaries of the Precious Blood who served here will be with you in spirit. We are always together in Christ, in the here and now, even though our bodies may be in different places. Our challenge as Christians is to refine our sense of Unity, so we can always share in the vision that binds us together around the world here and now as well as with the saints throughout all time. We need to realize how profoundly we are always connected to each other in Christ.
