We will be enjoying for the next few weeks, the Bread of Life series from the Gospel of John. The entire Eucharistic celebration itself is bread for life. We must work as a parish family and individually, to ensure that our bread for life does not become stale. The Mass is intended to be there to help us celebrate ordinary times in life, i.e. regular weekend Mass. High points such as Baptisms and Weddings and difficult times, such as struggling with great loss.

When too much focus is placed on convenience and routine, we can limit our ability to celebrate Eucharist as the whole parish family. The Catholic church calls the whole family to pray, together not just sections of it.
