Pastor's Column 9-16-2012

Stewardship – A Gift of Time

A Sacristan is someone who is willing to give the time to prepare for the necessary, immediate preparations, for celebration of the Eucharist.

The Sacristan sees to it that the Sanctuary is properly set up, i.e. the appropriate books are set to the right pages and vessels and linen are set out properly. In addition to the Sanctuary, the Sacristan ensures there is sufficient wine and bread placed on the table at the entrance of the church. St. Ann's has the tradition of having parishioners placing a host in the plate. This allows for the appropriate theological focus on receiving the Body of Christ that was given to us as part of this particular Eucharistic celebration. The practical concern can be to ensure there is enough hosts consecrated to meet the needs of the parish family. Thus, ensuring we have enough for the Mass being celebrated as well as having sufficient quantity of the Body of Christ reserved for visiting the sick as well as the occasional weekday Communion Service.

The Sacristan also ensures we have a sufficient number of folks ready to fulfill their assigned ministries for that Mass. As in most activities in life there is a need for time to clean up after the celebration is ended.

This is one of those ministries in which a lot of the work goes on behind the scenes.
