Bishop's Letter - 9/30/2012

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The 'Year of Faith' announced by Pope Benedict XVI begins October 11, the 50th anniversary of the opening of the Second Vatican Council. My wish is that this year can be a time of reflection and faith renewal for all Catholics.

On Sunday, October 28, our Diocese will officially begin its celebration of the Year of Faith in a historic way. Plans are in place for a first-of-its-kind-in-our-Diocese multicultural program that will involve and engage our entire Catholic community which includes a large and growing Hispanic membership.

The program will begin at 2:00 p.m. at the Cathedral in Jefferson City, with Mass scheduled to start around 5:00 p.m. Child care will be provided.

The afternoon will include my pastoral message on the Year of Faith, as well as a series of short and dynamic presentations by Dr. Hosffman Ospino, a theologian and professor at Boston College. The program includes music that will be provided by our many different parishes. The program will conclude with Mass and a Mexican-style meal that will be served afterward in the Cathedral undercroft for which a free will offering will be taken.

More information on this wonderful event will be provided in The Catholic Missourian in coming weeks, and other informational materials are on the way.

This is the first time in the history of our Diocese that we will celebrate and share our faith as one, diverse and multicultural Church. The event will certainly give witness to our faith and the universality of our Church. It would be wonderful to have participation from every parish as well as the various organizations in our Diocese!
