Diocese of Jefferson City to Air Advent Radio Spots calling Catholics back to Church

The Diocese of Jefferson City is airing commercial radio spots throughout the month of December in an Advent appeal that encourages inactive Catholics to attend weekend Mass. The 30-second spots feature Bishop John R. Gaydos, who offers a seasonal reflection and invites Catholics back to church. The ads were produced by the diocesan Communications Office with the support of a grant from the Missouri Knights of Columbus. The ads will run for four weeks on Jefferson City radio station 94.3 FM (KATI-KAT Country) beginning December 2 and on Eldon station 101.9 FM (KZVV-The Wave) starting Dec. 9. Those stations serve an area that includes a large portion of Diocese's parishes in central and northern Missouri.

Letter from Bishop Gaydos, Dec. 16, 2012

**COLLECTION TO AID VICTIMS OF
HURRICANE SANDY IN THE US
NORTHEAST**

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

A great amount of assistance has been provided to date to aid the victims of the terrible storm that struck the northeast U.S. this October. While a sincere thanks goes out to all those who have helped to date—unfortunately there is much more to be done. There are countless numbers of people who are still struggling to rebuild their lives in the midst of significant losses of their homes and nearly everything they owned.

Further, as is often the case, the Church in this area is both a responder and a victim. Many Church structures have been damaged and their resources depleted, and this makes it more difficult to provide aid and comfort—and the sacraments—to those in need.

The national Bishops' Conference is making a nationwide appeal to dioceses and parishes to take up a second collection sometime during this Advent and Christmas season to assist the people and the churches of the northeast coast of the United States. These funds will be used to support the efforts of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops and Catholic Charities, USA, the official domestic relief agency of the U.S. Catholic Church, as they respond to immediate emergency needs for such necessities as water, food, shelter, and medical care, as well as to the long term need to rebuild after widespread destruction, and to the pastoral and reconstruction needs of the Church.

I ask that we take up this second collection in the Diocese of Jefferson City on the weekend of December 22-23rd. The coordinating agency for this collection will be our own Catholic Charities of Central and Northern Missouri.

Thank you for your generosity during this special season.
