A Letter from our Bishop
Three-In-One Collection
March 2-3, 2013

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In Eastern Europe, young women seek employment abroad. In the process, many are kidnapped and forced to work as prostitutes instead. Catholic Relief Services in Bosnia reports that their “owners” may even lock the girls up in brothels while the sellers make \$3,000 per girl. Funds from the Catholic Relief Services Collection provide job skills and education, offering a defense to thousands of young women who can be saved from the horror of being sold for other people’s use.

Human trafficking is just one of the issues addressed through this annual Lenten collection. Your donations will help in CRS’ more familiar work of responding with life-saving assistance in natural disasters and meeting the needs of our world’s hungry poor.
