Prayer for Victims of Abuse

Dear God, We cry out for you to embrace with your gentleness and compassion victims of abuse of any kind. We know that in our midst there are those who are broken in spirit because of harsh and demeaning words that robbed them of the sense of their own immense value. Some have suffered violations of their bodies and had their trust of a neighbor, family member, teacher, or - to our profound grief - even a pastor bitterly betrayed. The walking wounded may cross our paths at any time. They sit beside us in desks at school, in office lunch rooms, at tables during family reunions and in pews at church. When their wounds are made known to us, we cringe in sadness over their pain and hurt. To you their agony was never hidden, your love never far. Father, help them to know your love and comfort. Restore their faith and trust in the beauty and goodness and truth of your love. In your kindness, restore them to wholeness.

Father, help us to see past the masks that hide abuse and stir our spirit to be alert to even silent calls for help. Help us always to offer the authentic embrace of your welcome and blessing to all of your children, to everyone we meet.
