Birthright Fundraiser Mother's Day Cards

Mother's Day is May 12th.

Did you know that 50% of pro-life respondents
recently polled did not know that Planned
Parenthood performed abortions? In fact it is the
largest abortion provider in the United States. In
2011, the last year for which the data is available,
Planned Parenthood performed 333,964 abortions,
or just over 27% of the current estimated number
of abortions performed in the United States. Yet of
the 45% who knew that Planned Parenthood
performs abortions, only 14% (6% of the entire
sample) knew that they perform over 300,000
abortions annually.

Founded in 1968, the National Right to Life
Committee (NRLC), the federation of 50 state
right-to-life affiliates and more than 3,000 local
chapters, is the nation's oldest and largest
grassroots pro-life organization. Recognized as the
flagship of the pro-life movement, NRLC works
through legislation and education to protect
innocent human life from abortion, infanticide,
assisted suicide and euthanasia.
