**Highlights from Parish Council Meeting** The  
meeting began with prayer by Fr. Mike, reminding  
us that some of the major goals we should work

The minutes and financial reports were reviewed  
and approved.

The new 6:00PM Saturday Mass was discussed.

Our parish is currently paying the fee for one  
family. The parish council is looking at the  
situation in order to make a recommendation to Fr.
