**BISHOP GAYDOS PASTORAL LETTER FOR
COLLECTION**

TO AID VICTIMS OF OKLAHOMA CITY

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Midwest has again experienced the terrible destruction and loss of life caused by a massive tornado. The national Bishops' Conference has made a nationwide appeal to dioceses and parishes to take up a second collection for the needs of Oklahoma City and the victims of other recent violent storms. All funds will be used to support the efforts of Catholic Charities USA (CCUSA), the official domestic relief agency of the U.S. Catholic Church, and the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, as they respond to emergency humanitarian needs for food, housing and medical care as well as the need for pastoral assistance and church-related building repair and reconstruction.

The Conference has already advanced some relief funds to the local Catholic Charities organization through CCUSA.

In the Diocese of Jefferson City, this second collection will be taken up in all parishes on the weekend of June 8-9. The coordinating agency for this collection will be our own Catholic Charities of Central and Northern Missouri.

Donating to the tornado relief fund will save lives, rebuild homes, provide shelter and supplies, and restore hope to those affected by the recent tornados in the Midwest. Please make out any checks to Catholic Charities CNM—Oklahoma City Disaster.
