### **Pastor's Column 6-9-13**

Tuesday June 4, 2013 I attended a mandatory Diocesan Stewardship meeting at our Chancery. Our Diocese is hiring a company to assist parishes in looking at Stewardship at the parish level. *This is NOT* a Diocesan Capital campaign. It is fair to say that this consulting company will place a strong focus on the treasure component of stewardship and it is up to the parish to follow through with the focus on time and talent.

This push on stewardship at the parish level will be implemented in the months to come. We received a good presentation on the program and I think that this is rather good timing in the life of St. Ann and Sts. Peter & Paul.

When I attend meetings or conferences on Stewardship, it reminds me of the vital importance of the role of stewardship in the life of the church. Our presenter made it clear that this process has been devised with being user friendly in mind.
